<u>National Day of Prayer – May 1st</u>: The Elders have decided to skip this year. We do invite the congregation to attend our monthly prayer time led by our Outreach Committee. Our next prayer time is <u>TONIGHT</u> immediately after the evening service. Prayer topics will include prayers for our nation, crops & industry, missions, and Christ's church.

<u>Update from the Elders</u>: The Elders thank the congregation for your support and faithfulness during this time of uncertainty. Here are a few items that the Elders have been working on. These matters have not been decided yet, but we felt the congregation should be aware of these things. If you have additional questions, please contact your district Elder.

<u>Pastor Vos</u>: Pastor Vos continues his 6-month leave of absence and has been actively seeking care to address his medical conditions. Please continue in prayer for Pastor Vos and Brenda as the recovery process has been difficult, slow and uneven. The Elders are committed to fully honor Pastor Vos's 6-month leave. But without jumping to conclusions, the Elders are preparing for the possibility that Pastor Vos would not be able to return as Senior Pastor at the end of his leave of absence, which is June 2, 2025. If Pastor Vos is not able to return as Senior Pastor, he has agreed that the best option is to file for long-term disability insurance coverage. Then, if Pastor Vos is not able to return as Senior Pastor, the Elders will immediately form a Search Committee to look for a suitable man to call as Senior Pastor of Cornerstone URC. Pastor Vos has graciously acknowledged that this would be the most prudent course of action for the good of the church, rather than waiting longer for his recovery.

<u>Dr. Jared Poulton</u>: Dr. Poulton has been appointed to be Director of IRBC starting on August 1, 2025. The Elders are having discussions with Dr. Poulton and IRBC so that he may serve this congregation in a limited part-time capacity starting August 1. We are grateful for Dr. Poulton's desire to minister in this way.
